Travel or gathering does increase your chance of getting and spreading COVID-19, so we are asking families to think about how they can make their holiday plans safer. Make safety a priority for your family and take these steps:

1. Check the map to find out the risk of COVID-19 infection at your destination,
2. Decide if the risk is worth it for your family,
3. Plan to have a safe trip or gathering, remain flexible and get your flu shot and
4. Quarantine when you return.

You can celebrate the holidays, but like other aspects of our lives right now, they will likely look different. Take extra precautions when attending or hosting an even and insist that people wear masks, keep gatherings small and cancel if anybody in your family is sick.

REMOTE families – we will notify you when your order is ready to be picked up at the store. We have curbside pickup options if you would rather not come into the store.

IN-PERSON families: Orders will be delivered to the school the week after the book fair ends.
